The Loft Artist Association is pleased to announce our 10th Annual Juried Exhibition. The Show dates are Saturday, September 9 – Sunday, October 8, 2023. An Opening Reception and Awards Ceremony will be held on Saturday, September 9 from 5-7 PM. The theme is open, and all artists are invited to submit. Artists can submit work via [EntryThingy](#).

The juror for the exhibit will be Kimberly Henrikson, who is in her 6th year as Executive Director at the Center for Contemporary Printmaking (CCP) after having previously held a seat on the CCP board and the Artist-in-Residence committee. Her involvement in the non-profit and fine art printmaking community has continued to expand and develop over the course of the past 15 years. For more than 12 years, Kimberly has been involved with the Print Club of New York, a membership group of print collectors in the New York City area for which she holds the position of Membership chair after eight years as President for the organization. She also serves on the National Advisory Council for the Palmer Museum of Art at Penn State University and the Advisory Board for the Norwalk Art Space with leaders in the arts community of Fairfield County. Kimberly received a BA in Art History from Penn State University and served two years as President of the Penn State College of Arts and Architecture Alumni Society Board. Currently, Kimberly resides in New Canaan, CT with her husband and son.

Founded in 1978, the Loft Artists Association is a non-profit organization of professional working artists dedicated to building connections within the visual arts community and offering many artistic and educational opportunities to the public, free of charge. As an established cultural institution, their grassroots events attract thousands of visitors throughout the Tri-state area and have been recognized by funding agencies, including the Connecticut Commission on the Arts, corporate and private sponsors, the City of Stamford and by visitors who return year after year.
